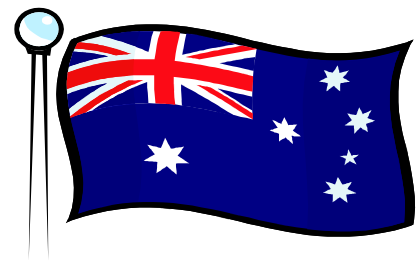
Ginger Flower & Food Festival....

Things to remember about Dicky Beach Family Holiday Park

BOOMGATES

The access number for the Boomgates issued to you upon checking in needs to be entered at all times when entering or exiting the park. Even if you are following a vehicle in or out of the park or the Boomgate is up you still must enter your access number followed by the # key. This is a security code and if misused can restrict your access when entering or exiting the park.

Guests please remember only one vehicle per site

SECURITY

Though we have security in the park we ask that you still lock away all your valuables. Please do not leave valuables outside your vans or tents, unfortunately thieves do not go on holidays!

SAFETY!

Unfortunately we do not permit the riding of bikes, skateboards, scooters and/or roller blades within the park.

Reminder to all guests that when driving within the park to keep your vehicle at **10km (walking pace)** for the safety of everyone in the park.

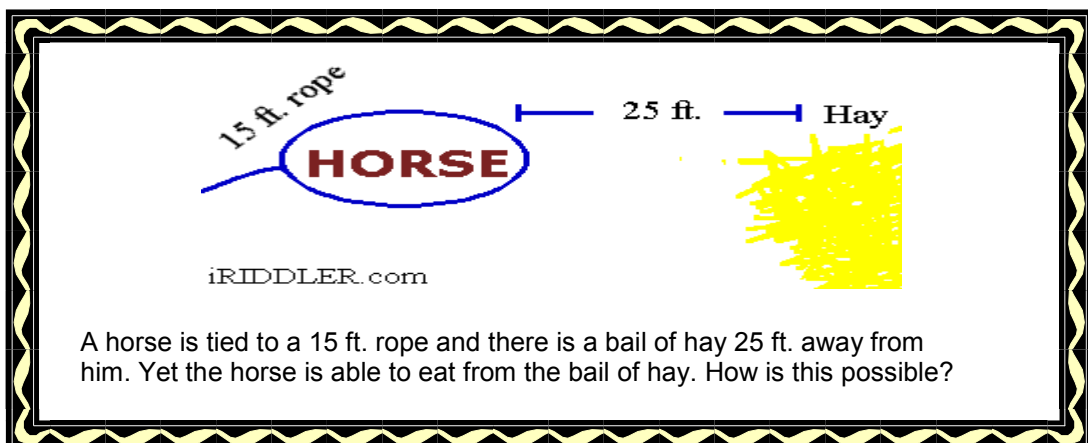
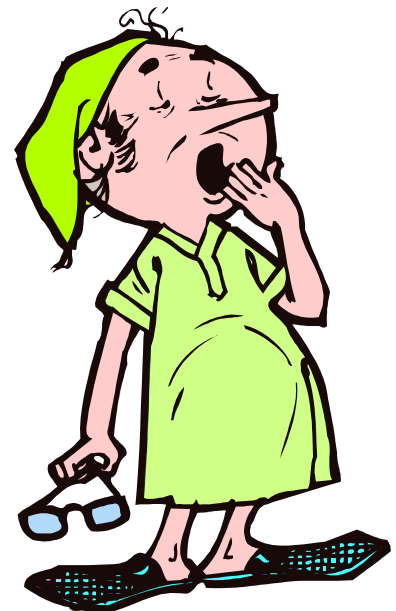

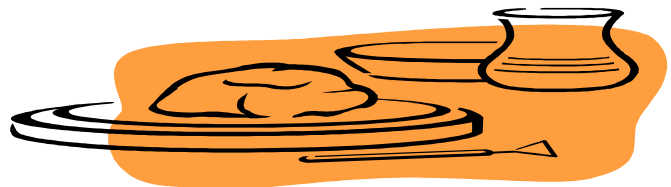
